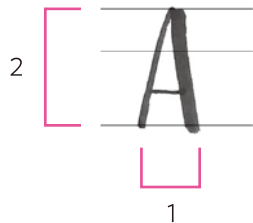
Hand Lettering Font Vol. 2

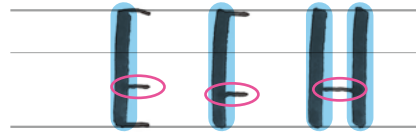
With **Brush Sign Pen**, even beginners can enjoy writing calligraphy with ease!

How to Write Hand Lettering Font Vol. 2

1. The letters should have a height-to-width ratio of 2:1.



2. Vertical lines are thick, while horizontal ones are thin.



3. For oval letters, only the left side is thick.



4. Writing crossbars (horizontal lines) just above or below the center adds a touch of flair.
